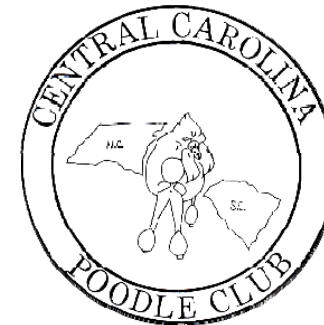

CONFIRMATIONS

- Confirmations will be sent via US mail ONLY if an exhibitor does not have an active e-mail address or upon specific request.
- A Preliminary Confirmation will be sent to the e-mail address on the AKC entry form after your entry has been processed. Please review the information in the confirmation for input errors and notify the Trial Secretary of any corrections.
- Final confirmations of entry and judging schedule will be sent to the e-mail address on the AKC form after the closing date.

NOTE: If the exhibitor has not received the Final confirmation within five days of the trial, please contact the Trial Secretary.

ENTRY INFORMATION

- Type or **PRINT** neatly
- Entry fees are \$23 for the 1st entry of a dog and \$13 for each additional entry of the same dog on the SAME DAY (includes AKC recording fee of \$3 per run/per dog/per day).
- Make checks payable to **Central Carolina Poodle Club (CCPC)** and mail to Trial Secretary at the PO Box address.
- Be sure to include the correct fees. Overpayments less than \$10 will not be refunded.
- Entries **open** Tuesday, April 21, 2009 at 8am and will be accepted on a first received basis.
- Entries **close** on Tuesday, May 26, 2009 at 6pm.
- All entries must be submitted on official AKC agility entry forms, one dog per entry form. Photocopies of front & back will be accepted only if legible and official AKC size.
- Entries will not be accepted without signature, back of entry form with agreement, and fees, nor will telephone or FAX entries will be accepted.
- Owners are responsible for ensuring that entry forms are completed IN FULL. Entries submitted without ALL information will be returned as invalid.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. A \$25.00 service fee will be added for all returned checks.
- If you use a delivery service, you MUST check the "NO SIGNATURE REQUIRED" box, as the Trial Secretary will not be present to sign for your entries.
- **THIS CLUB DOES NOT AGREE TO ARBITRATE CLAIMS AS SET FORTH ON THE OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORM FOR THIS EVENT**

INVALID ENTRIES

Invalid entries will be returned to the address on the entry form. The following constitute an invalid entry:

- An entry which is missing any AKC required information
- Entries not on Official AKC forms OR on a photocopy of an AKC form without the current agreement and rule on the reverse side or attached to the entry form
- Entries which are illegible, or incomplete
- Entries received with insufficient fees
- Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, e-mail, telephone, FAX, or telegraph entries cannot be accepted.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry
- A maximum of ten entries per envelope is allowed. Envelopes with more than the ten dog maximum shall be treated as an invalid entry and shall be returned to the sender.

PLEASE CHECK YOUR ENTRIES CAREFULLY!

I answer all correspondence and acknowledge receipt of all move-ups and corrections to entries. If you do not get a response from me, please call me.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

It is expressly understood that the exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any entry fees will be made.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that the dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Bitches in season will not be admitted to the trial. Any exhibitor with a bitch entered, which is in season on the trial date, will be refunded the entry fee, less \$10 (each day). Notification must be in the hands of the trial secretary no later than 8 AM on the date of the trial.

Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. No classes will be held up by a late exhibitor.

All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. No dogs may be left tied to trees, cars, fences, etc.

Dogs under 6 months of age are not allowed at this trial.

Due to limited crating space at this trial, unentered dogs will NOT be permitted. Please consider this before entering this trial!

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club, or are registerable breeds that have obtained an AKC, ILP, or PAL number. Dogs eligible for entry in the Miscellaneous Class at dog shows are eligible to participate. Bitches in season, aggressive dogs, dogs that are blind or deaf or suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect its physical or mental performance are not eligible to participate.

RIBBONS AND AWARDS

Rosettes and a dog related toy or treats (valued up to \$2) will be awarded to the first through fourth place dog in each jump height division in each class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Dogs must qualify to receive placement ribbons. New title ribbons will be given to those earning a title at our trial. MACH Rosettes and a MACH bar will be given to exhibitors earning a MACH title at this trial.

All ribbons and prizes must be claimed the day of the Trial. None will be mailed.

CLASSES OFFERED

All regular and preferred Standard and JWW will be offered on Saturday and Sunday. Please consult AKC rules and regulations pertaining to Agility Trials for complete description and eligibility for entry in these classes. The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct class/division.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS

Owners/Agents are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. All height divisions will be offered in both the standard classes and the jumpers with weaves classes. PLEASE SEND A PHOTOCOPY OF YOUR JUMP HEIGHT CARD. DOGS WITH NO CARD MUST BE MEASURED PRIOR TO RUNNING.

All A & B classes will be combined with B classes running first, then A classes followed by Preferred within each jump height. Regular and Preferred Classes will run concurrently.

OBSTACLES

All obstacles and equipment used at this trial meet the requirements for agility trials.

Single copies of the latest edition of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows and Regulations for Agility Trials may be obtained from the American Kennel Club, 8051 Arco Corporate Drive, Suite 100, Raleigh, NC 27617-3390, or from the AKC web site at www.akc.org. These contain all AKC rules that apply to this trial, including descriptions of dogs eligible to enter, class descriptions, height card requirements and obstacle specifications.

OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- Please be considerate of space limitations when parking/setting up.
- **NO XPENS or LaFuma chairs are permitted in the crating area.**
- The building will be available for a limited time on Friday afternoon for setup. This information will be included in the confirmation letter.
- NO SMOKING WITHIN THE BUILDINGS OR WITHIN 10 FEET OF ANY BUILDING. Please use the butt cans that will be provided to put out and dispose of any cigarettes.
- Outside shade is very limited. If you do not plan on crating indoors please bring shade for your dogs.

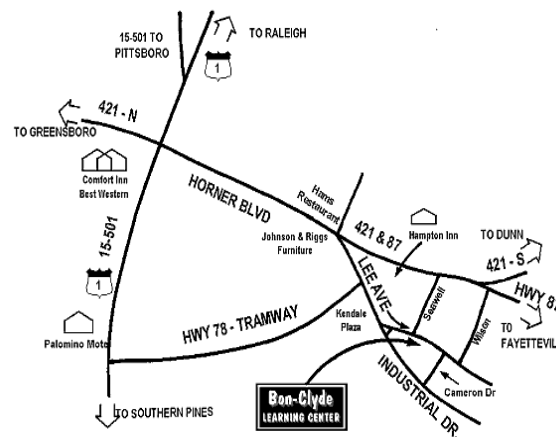

Dogs entered in the *Preferred* classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. The Judge's measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.
